# Principal's Message

Last week we had a great Remembrance Day Assembly organized by our Grade 8 students.

This week is Anti Bullying Week. We will spend some time discussing with all our students the 4 R's of Bullying Recognize, Refuse, Report and Restore. "Bullying" means aggressive and typically repeated behaviour by a child or youth. Bullying is defined as a "typically a form of repeated, persistent, and aggressive behaviour directed at an individual or individuals that is intended to cause (or should be known to cause) fear and distress and/or harm to another person's body, feelings, self-esteem, or reputation. Bullying occurs in a context where there is a real or perceived power imbalance".

We will have Nonquon Outdoor Ed visit with our Grade 7 and 8s exploring outdoor education with them this week. MAAD will also be doing a virtual presentation for our intermediate students this week.

**A reminder to all Visitors and Parents:** Non-essential visitors and parents are not allowed in the school. Whenever possible, telephone meetings with parents/guardians should be held. If a child forgets their lunch. Parents will be allowed to come through the front door and drop their lunch on a table labelled with their child's name. Mrs. Rodriguez will ensure that students receive their lunches.
